I would like to announce a **call for applications for the Student Award** for 2023 from the Association of Clinical and Translational Statisticians (ACTStat). The purpose of the Award is to recognize the meritorious works and achievements of a student in support of a clinical or translational science team through the practice of statistics. Students enrolled in a full-time graduate program during the current academic year (2022-2023) are eligible to apply. The student award winner will be invited to present at the annual meeting and receive a \$250 honorarium. The conference registration fee will also be waived.

## **Demonstrate what you have done that has contributed to team science!**

- To be considered for the Student Award, please submit (1) an abstract or published manuscript, (2) a statement of how your work has made an impact in supporting a team and/or translational science, and (3) a resume or CV. (Past recipients of the Student Award are no longer eligible.)

The meeting this year will be held in Toronto on August 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> just prior to the Joint Statistical Meetings. The student award winner will be selected by a committee assembled by the president elect of ACTStat.

**The deadline for submission is Friday, April 14, 2023.**

The 2023 ACTStat Annual Meeting provides an excellent opportunity to network with researchers interested in enhancing the design, implementation, and analysis of clinical and translational studies. Highlights of the 2023 ACTStat meeting will include:

- podium presentations from leading biostatisticians in clinical and translational science
